Chike,

Sunday we had a high voltage (14,700 volts) sectionalizer damaged by a vehicle, the sectionalizer belongs to us. We had Cache Valley Electric send a lineman crew out to assess the damage, to make it safe they had to disconnect power from the sectionalizer which removed power to three buildings and our radar site. In addition to the work they completed today, they are going to provide us a price to replace the sectionalizer which we think will fall in around \$15k.

The main problem I see here is that CVE is not on a state contract that I can find to perform electrical work.

Given the emergent nature of the situation I would like authorization to complete this transaction in the most expedient manner possible and direct award this to CVE once the price comes in as long as it appears reasonable.

This will be using our Master Cooperative Agreement, 100% Federal funding using the state procurement system.

The federal government will be seeking damages from the party which damaged the equipment.

Please provide us with additional guidance or authorization to proceed with CVE.

Dear Robert,

Cache Valley Electric is pleased to provide the Utah Air National Guard with this quote to supply and replace the damaged ground sleeve at your facilities which was damaged on 7/13/20. The cost for the labor, equipment and material and service call would be **\$6,152.38**.

Below is a breakout of the costs:

Service Call (Disconnect Power) 2 Hrs. = \$180.58

Labor = \$2,356.94

Equipment = \$1,044.16

Material = \$2,570.70 (includes 10% mark-up)

Total = \$6,152.38

If any additional cable work is required such as splicing, there would be some additional costs. But talking to Troy he does not feel that will be the case at this time.
